Provides an in-home comprehensive geriatric assessment to those with complex health concerns, medical needs and/or memory changes. The geriatric nurse works with a specialist to provide recommendations to your primary care team and can help to link you with local resources.

Provides an urgent in-home assessment for older adults with dementia, mental health concerns, addictions, or other neurological conditions who have challenging behaviours that are causing distress for the person, their family members or the persons that care for them. We work collaboratively with caregivers, families and other health care professionals to create strategies to manage the behaviour and provide support.

Provides an in-clinic comprehensive geriatric assessment. The Geriatrician and team provide care for a wide range of issues impacting older adults and provide a full report and recommendations to your primary care provider.
